The PVA Pistol Shoot will consist of 50 rounds of ammunition. Handguns will not be provided. No scopes or laser sights allowed, and nothing smaller than .32 caliber or larger than .45 caliber will be authorized for competition. The use of two hands is ok, as is the use of a safety strap for all wheelchair shooters. However, hands and arms must be completely free of support. Competition is open to all shooters, sitting or standing. Absolutely no reloaded ammunition may be used for practice or competition.

Course of Fire:

- 10 shots of practice, 10 minutes.
- Slow fire at the 15-yard line, 10 shots in 10 minutes
- Quick fire at the 15-yard line, 5 shots in 30 seconds
- Quick fire at the 15-yard line, 5 shots in 30 seconds
- Slow fire at the 20-yard line, 10 shots in 10 minutes
- Quick fire at the 20-yard line, 5 shots in 30 seconds
- Quick fire at the 20-yard line, 5 shots in 30 seconds
